

The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) Election Notice UCA 20A-16-502 July 25, 2025

This is a municipal year of elections; therefore, you will only receive a ballot if your city has a mayoral or council seats that are up for election. Utah County will be gaining a new city: Spring Lake, Utah. There will be an election for their mayor and city council seats. Alpine School District (ASD) will also be splitting into 3 school boards. If you are part of the ASD, you will also have your new school board seat on your ballot.

Electronic ballots must be received by the Elections Office by 8:00 PM (Mountain Standard Time) on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2025. Mailed ballots must be postmarked no later than the day before Election Day, Monday, November 3, 2025, and received up through the Election Canvass.
